1,000 STUDY GROUPS: THE NEXT GREAT STEP FOR THE URANTIA REVELATION

Every Tuesday night for the past 45 years, my calendar has been booked for our study group. This group has been together since the 1970s, evolving from in-person meetings into a Zoom family after COVID. It is, simply put, a spiritual family: a place for learning and loving.

Since the first printing in 1955, the priorities of the revelation have included translations, book distribution, socialization, and building the financial infrastructure to support all of these efforts. We are now moving into the next important phase—creating and expanding into

thousands of independent study groups worldwide.

Thousands of study groups must be brought into existence and the book must be translated into many tongues. Thus will the book be in readiness when the battle for man's liberty is finally won and the world is once more made safe for the religion of Jesus and the freedom of mankind.

Why Study Groups Matter

The Urantia Book teaches that religion is primarily a personal connection between the individual and God. However, it also reminds us that sharing spiritual insights enhances that connection. Study groups offer a space to ask questions, explore teachings, pray, worship together, and reflect on how to live as a child of God. For both new and experienced readers, they help build friendships grounded in spiritual values and intellectual growth.

Why Decentralized Study Groups?

Decentralized study groups allow the revelation to grow naturally and resiliently. From on high, they may appear like *shining lights spreading across the world*. When thousands of small circles of believers study and live these teachings, the revelation becomes both unstoppable and strong. The power of decentralization is based on several key truths:

- Thousands of small independent groups don't have a single point of institutional failure—no imposed hierarchy, no fossilized truth.
- Each independent group adapts naturally to its own culture and community while remaining unified with all readers through the teachings.
- Decentralization fosters personal religion while fulfilling the deep human need for spiritual fellowship.
- History teaches that no transformation of


religion comes without conflict. Thousands of independent groups, however, are extraordinarily difficult to attack and silence.

UPDATES FROM THE JANUARY 2026 TRUSTEE MEETING

Books

Tamara Strumfeld reported that Urantia Foundation had another successful year for book distribution, and the goal of a 7% increase was attained! Sales totaled 23,928 copies, up 7% from 2024. Downloads totaled 53,567 books, up 21% for the year. Donated books totaled 1,657 copies, up 17% for the year.

The top priorities for the first quarter of 2026 include overseeing book

printings and the testing of a new book app for Android and Apple devices.

Cultural Advisory Council (CAC)

Chris Wood announced the new cohort of four CAC members. The liaison team was careful to consider time zones since the advisors are expected to attend one another's meetings. They decided to focus on multinational readers from Europe, South America, and Africa.

Education

Joanne Strobel reported that the September trimester of Urantia Book International School (UBIS)

wrapped up on November 23. They enrolled 277 students into 19 courses, presented by 26 facilitators representing eight language branches. French courses

resumed and enjoyed a great turnout. Myra Hight joined the Foundation's UBIS team in October to manage the English branch.

Chris Wood reported on the success of the November Science Symposium and observed that the videos have received lots of views. The Education Committee is hosting an additional quarterly meeting of interorganizational education leaders to update one another on their respective activities. They collectively decided to focus the reader community on the importance of study groups.

Q4 Fundraising and Finances

- Unrestricted donations fell 19% below Q4 of 2024 but were up 30% for the year.
- Restricted donations rose 29% above Q4 of 2024 and were up 15% for the year.
- Total income rose 22% over Q4 of 2024 and was 43% over budget.
- Total YTD expenses rose 5% over 2024 but came in 8% under budget.

Governance

The Governance Committee reviewed and discussed the

results of a board assessment that was conducted in November. The trustees are committed to ensuring that the expanded board functions effectively and is strategically aligned with the Foundation's mission and values.

Mustard Seed Grants Program

Sherry Cathcart Chavis reported that there will be two interactive information sessions on Zoom to help applicants understand the application process and expectations. The dates for these sessions were January 30 and February 6. The staff of Urantia

Foundation will continue to guide grant applicants throughout the process and will help ensure that grantees carefully read the Letter of Agreement before signing.

Translations

Reports were given on the progress of the Esperanto, Farsi, Greek, and Tagalog translations, the Portuguese revision, the Spanish 1993 correction project, and the Spanish 2021 revision refinement project. There have been some text updates for the Dutch, Polish, and Simplified Chinese translations.

CHICAGO'S TUESDAY EVENING STUDY GROUP

Editor's Note: Study groups have long been one of the most meaningful ways readers engage with the teachings of The Urantia Book. As part of a renewed emphasis on growing study groups worldwide, News Online will begin featuring stories from study group hosts. We start with Chicago's Tuesday evening study group at 533 W Diversey Parkway.

Urantia Foundation, the original publisher, has long supported education and the study of *The Urantia Book*. For decades, since the 1920s, the Forum Room on the second floor at 533 Diversey Parkway has served as a welcoming place where readers gather to explore the teachings together.

The Tuesday Evening Study Group has continued steadily in the Forum

Room—week after week, year after year—forming friendships and connections that have become a kind of extended family.

Our group studies *The Urantia Book* sequentially, reading and discussing the text at a thoughtful pace. Typically, meeting once a week, it takes four to five years to complete the full journey from cover to cover. Then we start again from page one, and, as many readers will attest, we continue to learn new insights each read-through.

In 2018, Zoom technology was introduced so those who could not attend physically could still participate. When the pandemic arrived in 2020, the group moved fully online, and readers from around the country—and eventually around the world—began joining the Tuesday evening conversations.

Today the group has become a hybrid gathering. A few participants attend in person at the Foundation, while others join from their homes across the United States and beyond. Those who gather in person often enjoy dinner together beforehand at one of the nearby restaurants. These informal meals help strengthen the friendships that grow naturally when people spend time studying, reflecting, and getting to know one another.

Like any long-running study group, consistency has been one of the keys to its longevity. With only the occasional holiday break, participants know that Tuesday evening will almost



always find this small community gathering again—opening the book, reading together, and sharing insights.

For many of us, the Tuesday Evening Study Group has become a small but steady light in the week—a warm, friendly, and comfortable environment—and a welcomed break from our busy lives.

We remain grateful to Urantia Foundation for providing a welcoming and historically meaningful place where readers can gather to study and reflect on these supernal teachings.



MUSTARD SEED GRANT—DISSEMINATING THE REVELATION IN CHILE, ITALY, AND MALTA


In the early 1970s a Urantia Book reader told me a story. She was walking down a library aisle when a Urantia Book dropped off an upper shelf and landed right in front of her! She became a lifelong reader and teacher of the revelation. That story has been my inspiration to place copies of *The Urantia Book* in as many libraries on Planet 606 as I can. I believe that if we just get the book out there, we can leave the rest to our unseen friends and the Spirit of Truth.

I have been privileged to meet some of the people who found one of those "Library Placement" books.

One book placed in a library on the Spanish island of Tenerife found its way to Hara Davis, who went on to produce many *Urantia Book* study guides. Another copy left at Findhorn in the north of Scotland in 1973 was found by someone who later started a study group in England. I had the fortune of meeting him years later at a European conference where we put two and two together. I have no doubt there are countless other souls quietly enriched by books donated to libraries in corners of the world I may never know.

More recently the Mustard Seed Grants Program (MSGP) has supported my efforts to place books in libraries in Hawaii and Chile (2023), and in Ireland (2025). My husband, Matt, and I have just completed our third project of placing 30 *Urantia Books*. The recipients were nine libraries on the island of Chiloe, located off mainland Chile, and another in the large city of Osorno, which is north of our second home. Mark Wood helped by placing 10 more books in libraries on the islands of Malta, his home country. The final 10 are being placed in Italy.

It has been a pleasure working with Urantia Foundation and friends both seen and unseen to help spread the fifth epochal revelation to this "strife-torn world."



MUSTARD SEED GRANT— THE KITCHEN TABLE SERIES

Editor's Note: The Urantia Book Fellowship was a recipient of the second round of Mustard Seed Grant awards in 2024. The following article is a report on this completed project.

Inspired by a church event called “God and Coffee,” the Kitchen Table educational series was created to help students of *The Urantia Book* share soulful discussions with the people they see every day, and to foster deeper relationships with them. In a world of technology with increasing levels of isolation, many feel they are living in a neighborhood without neighbors. Fewer and fewer of us really know the people we interact with “in real life.” How do we move beyond the superficial and talk about life’s big questions with friends, family, and neighbors?

We developed [a series of short videos](#) based on the teachings of *The Urantia Book*. Our goal was threefold: Interfaith, interesting, and family friendly. The videos were designed for study group leaders or readers who simply want to share the teachings and integrate them into everyday life. The selected topics were intentionally broad so that readers and nonreaders can share and learn from different points of view.

The five to seven questions that accompany each video invite discussion on important topics such as “The Universal Father,”

“Evolution,” “The Nature of Evil,” “Life in the Universe,” “The Value of Religion,” and “The Teachings of Jesus.” They are available in Spanish and English.

Early results have been promising. One study group leader shared, “I made a postcard and dropped it at 35 homes: You’re Invited! Neighborhood Open House and Discussion Hour on ‘The Big Questions.’ This week: Evolution. Coffee, tea, and snacks provided; children of all ages welcome.”

The surprising turnout included Hindu, Chinese, nonreligious, Catholic, and

atheist neighbors, all living within a two-block radius! Three school-age children attended and were wonderful icebreakers, enthusiastically raising their hands to ask about dinosaurs, and whether extinct animals can ever come back. Given unanimous interest, the group plans to meet again to discuss other life in the universe, aliens, and extraterrestrials.

MUSTARD SEED GRANT— THE URANTIA REVELATION CHANNEL

The Urantia Revelation Channel debuted on YouTube in 2023 with an initial grant from the Mustard Seed Grants Program (MSGP) and an additional Second Miler Grant from the Urantia Book Fellowship. Our videos explain *The Urantia Book* to younger readers using popular language and a tutorial format where we respond to questions from viewers.

Since 2023, we have published 50 documentary-style videos, most in Indonesian, since 90% of our viewers are local. With a current subscriber count of 2,062, the channel has received 143,000 views,

totaling 14,200 hours of viewing time.

With input from the MSGP team, we have improved the scripting and video creation. By digging deeper into the text, we are able to present *The Urantia Book* as a superior text for today's modern age, integrating the origins, histories, and

destinies of the cosmos, the galaxies, our planet, mankind, and Jesus.

We are grateful to Urantia Foundation's MSGP. In addition to a new community of subscribers, we now have 15 advanced readers in our WhatsApp group, many of whom meet weekly on Zoom. Jacinta Rini and I

are also facilitating Indonesian courses for Urantia Book International School (UBIS).

THE PERSONALITY APPROACH RETREAT

In early March a small group of 10 gathered at Urantia Foundation for a three-day retreat exploring the "Personality Approach" to reality. We began with a Jeffersonian dinner, where each participant shared a personal story about themselves, their family, or their ancestors. Those stories quickly created a circle of trust—an atmosphere of openness, laughter, and heartfelt sharing that set the tone for our time together.

Over the following days we explored the remarkable divine gift of personality and the spiritual journey of becoming fully who we are created to be. Our conversation followed the ideas, ideals, and contemplative practices shared in the text, *The Beatitudes: Explorations in the Attitude of the Soul*, with reference to Paper 140 of *The Urantia Book*. Our periods of silence and shared reflections reminded us that while the revelation often first appeals to the intellect, the deeper work of transformation takes place in the heart—where

compassion, healing, and love engage their quiet work.

Each day included time for worship and stillness, reflecting the simple but powerful discipline of spending intentional time with the divine presence within, our divine appointment with God. As I often tell my students, even a few minutes of quiet each day can open the door to a quality of wisdom that can help us recognize the sacred personality in every person we encounter.

Our time together was enriched by the warm hospitality of Mike Wood and Evette Twyford, whose meals and gracious care helped create a welcoming environment. On Friday evening we also enjoyed a tour of the Foundation, including the remarkable Melchizedek Library of historical materials and the collection of pottery bearing the ancient three concentric circles from Cyprus. Fossils, stones, minerals, and artwork celebrating the Life Carriers and the evolution of life on our world are displayed as well.

Participants left with deep appreciation for the opportunity to share stories, explore spiritual practice, and rediscover the creative and sacred gift of personality. My hope is that each of us continues the quiet work we began together—setting aside time each day to sit in stillness with the divine presence within, allowing wisdom, compassion, and love to

guide the unfolding of our unique personality. And, more importantly, may we come to see three essentials about ourselves and others: first, the sacred dimension of every other person; second, that every person deserves beloved community; and finally, that

every person, through God's will, has a gift unique unto themselves that enriches all of us.

May your smile be blessed by your heart, and may it bring this blessing to each person you meet!

WHAT *THE URANTIA BOOK* MEANS TO ME

I was given a copy of *The Urantia Book* by a friend in 2008 after the Sunday service at our spiritualist church, the Sanctuary of Light. A relative had sent it to her, but since she spoke Afrikaans, she said I could have it since she didn't understand the English. I took the book and flipped it over to read the description. I was intrigued by the fact that Part IV was about the life and teachings of Jesus. I was even more fascinated by the authorship. Now I really became excited, certain that I would learn more truths about Jesus. I hurried home, determined to read this book as soon as possible.

I had no problem with the English, and that night as I started to read, I realized that this was a book that needed to be read in small doses; to be savored, like an elixir of life. I cried when I read of Jesus' crucifixion and his suffering, but I loved the way the soldiers

were "spooked." I slowly worked my way through Part IV and then turned my attention to the front of the book. I discovered strange new words, and learned about morontia, Mighty Messengers, and mansion worlds. The concept of Thought Adjusters was easy for me to understand because as a spiritualist, I believe we have spiritual guides with us in our daily lives.

The Urantia Book confirmed many of my spiritualist beliefs. For example, our mission statement says, "The Sanctuary of Light brings spiritual enlightenment to ALL people regardless of their race, religion, or creed." I am reminded of Jesus traveling about, speaking to various groups of people. Regardless of what prejudices they may have held, he opened their minds to look at their situations in a different light.

I discovered Urantia Book International School (UBIS) in 2017 and began to study online. Since that time, I have completed 13 courses on a wide variety of subjects. In 2018 I learned of a retreat for women at Urantia Foundation headquarters, called "Dancing with God—Courageously Living His Love."

When I mentioned to my family that I wanted to attend they all said, "It's a scam! Don't waste your money." That made me even more determined, and I made the long flight from Johannesburg to Chicago. I so enjoyed the retreat and was delighted to meet other readers.

I had donated my copy of *The Urantia Book* to the Sanctuary of Light's library. South African bookshops don't stock this kind of book, and Amazon doesn't deliver because there is a high risk that the delivery drivers may get hijacked. So, I was delighted to find another copy in 2020 through Takealot, South Africa's largest online retailer. I also have a copy

of *The Untold Story of Jesus* with its beautiful paintings.

I have given many readings and addresses at the Sanctuary of Light using themes from *The Urantia Book*. I have even read the Our Father prayer. I emphasize that the unity of truth, beauty, and goodness can only be realized in the spiritual experience of the God-knowing personality, and that the great challenge to modern man is to achieve better communication with the divine presence within.

I end this story with the words we always use at the Sanctuary of Light: "I leave this with you in love and light."
