

Updates from the October 2022 Trustee Meeting

Operations Overview

Books

- Total Urantia Book sales for Q3 were down 24%. YTD was down 1%. Total sales for Q3—including Urantia Press titles—were down 26%. YTD was down 1%.
- Downloads were down 24% for the quarter, and down 25% YTD.
- E-books were down 7% for the quarter, and up 5% YTD.
- The Audio Enablement Project is nearing completion. We anticipate launching audiobooks in 20 languages in mid-2023.

Education

• The Urantia Book International School (UBIS) opened the current trimester on September 12. The website was updated to include courses in 3 new languages—German, Hungarian, and Polish. In total, 20 courses in 7 languages are in session.

• The Urantia Study Group Directory team approved a coding project that will enhance their ability to automate the yearly clean-up process. An up-to-date directory is their highest priority. A total of 543 groups in 63 countries are registered. The top 5 languages are English, Spanish, Portuguese, French, and Korean.

Fundraising and Finances

- Donations—Q3 unrestricted donations were 52% above budget, and up 58% YTD. Restricted donations came in 23% below budget for the quarter, but still above budget YTD. Total income is up 46% from 2021 and up 80% from the budget.
- Estate gifts—Q3 estate gifts were \$15,359 compared to \$0 in Q3 2021. YTD estate gifts were \$641,654 compared to \$813,213 in 2021.
- Expenses—Total expenses are up 13% from 2021 but 8% below budget.

Translations and Revisions

Updates were provided on the translations and revisions in progress.

• Congratulations to the Filipino translation team for finishing Paper 31, which

means the entire Part I is complete.

- The Farsi translation is now over 90% complete and available on our website. Our translator is sending the Foundation one paper per month and expects to finish in August of 2024.
- The Greek revisors are pleased to report that they have finished Paper 154 of Βιβλίο της Ουράντια.
- The Hungarian revision is complete and has been printed. Books will be available for purchase by mid-December across Hungary.

- Heartfelt thanks go to Paul and Gosia Jaworski for finishing their third revision of *Ksiegi Urantii*. The text will be printed once the current inventory sells.
- The Portuguese team continues to make significant progress with their revision of *O Livro de Urântia*.

Cultural Advisory Council

Ms. Krystyna Piasecka presented a moving PowerPoint on the historical, geographical, and cultural evolution of Poland and its people. Through touching videos and her unique perspective, she brought us through millennia weaving throughout their story an enlightened understanding and appreciation of the Polish people and just why

their population appears primed to embrace the truths of the fifth epochal revelation. <u>Read Krystyna's</u> article on page 3.

Some highlights of Q3 2022 include:

- Brought on four new trustees to the board.
- Coordinated the printing of 10,000 Hungarian, Italian, Portuguese, and Spanish EE books.
- Sold the remaining 1,000 Korean books in Korea for outreach purposes.
- Hired Hanno van der Plas of the Netherlands as the new European Book Sales Manager.

THE CULTURAL ADVISORY COUNCIL WELCOMES POLAND

It was an honor for me to introduce Poland on behalf of the Foundation's Cultural Advisory Council. Especially since, as an ordinary Polish reader who currently lives in Norway, I didn't think I could face such a special responsibility. During my presentation at the October meeting of the Board of Trustees. I wanted to introduce Poland in such a way as to allow others to get to know the Polish nation better. Out of a huge number of facts, I presented those that are not commonly known. To me, it is the people, not the territory. that form the country.

Poland is often referred to as an Eastern European country. This term is related to nomenclature dating back to the Cold War or earlier. Depending on the type of criterion adopted, the geographical center of Europe is located somewhat east of Poland.

Poles, along with many other Europeans, belong to the cultural group called Slavs, which brings together many ethnic groups sharing similar values, culture, and beliefs. Let the Slavic attitude, which captures values outlined in *The Urantia Book*, be commonly known: "Guest at home, God at home."

European history, including Poland, is turbulent. In the last millennium, Poland's borders have changed many times. After the union between the Polish and Lithuanian nations. the territory was partitioned by neighboring countries three times, until it disappeared from world maps for 123 years. Subsequently, the territory was the scene of two world wars, as well as the Cold War. It was the shared values and ideals that held the society together and allowed it to survive.

Numerous university studies are devoted to the Polish-Lithuanian Commonwealth. A special research center dedicated to the historical, social, and cultural legacy of this very union has been established at the University of Aberdeen, This commonwealth, established in 1569, was one of the largestif not the largest-European states of its time. Some researchers note that this union was something different from earlier and later ones, and call it a "fraternal union of people, not states."

One feature worth mentioning is the *liberum veto*—based on the thesis that there will always be someone righteous to say "I disagree"—the right of an individual to end a session of the Sejm (the national legislature). Others include the first free royal elections (1573); the merger of the Orthodox Church with the Roman Catholic Church (1596); and Europe's first, and the world's second, constitution (1791).

Statistics Office surveys show homogeneity of religion. As


many as 90% of those surveyed declared their belonging to the Roman Catholic Church in 2018. However, there have been significant changes in recent years. The Center for Public Opinion Research (CBOS) shows that there has been an overall continuous decline in people participating in religious practices. The younger the group, the higher the percentage of nonpractitioners. This decline suggests that Poles declare their faith but are moving away from the institution of the church.

Poles are a nation of hardworking, courageous, resourceful, and persistent people of action. A country of many Nobel Prize winners, explorers, discoverers, mathematicians, physicists, writers, and artists whose achievements we benefit from every day. You probably know of more than one famous person from Poland but wouldn't suspect them of being born there.

The tumultuous history of Poland has led to mistrust among Poles. Perhaps this explains why activities relating to *The Urantia Book* tend to be mostly individualistic. Sociologists have predicted that Poles will eventually overcome generations of inherited distrust and begin to act together, sharing insights. They will broaden and enrich each other's perspectives and insights through cooperation.

With almost 8,000 books in print, the number of readers of *Ksiegi Urantii* is growing. It will be good to see a cohesive community grow through participating in Polish study groups, Urantia Book International School online courses, and social media. It is in the youngest generation of seekers that the power to make change lies, and it is in their direction that we should look.

In 2023, the four members of the Cultural Advisory Council will be planning virtual meetings between local readers and Foundation trustees. This could bring important and positive changes for what is one of the most numerous European reading groups.

NURTURING THE REVELATION IN THE PHILIPPINES

Editor's Note: The Asidaos began their personal outreach program in the Philippines in 2014. Urantia Foundation has supported their efforts through the donation of hundreds of Urantia Books. Thanks to Eugene and Belen's generous and selfless service, the local readership has grown steadily, and the Filipino translation team is making great progress.

After two and a half years in quarantine, my husband Eugene and I prayed that the COVID epidemic would end. We longed for the day when Urantia Book study groups could once again meet face to face. Above all, we were excited to return to our country of origin, the Philippines, so we could continue the outreach work begun almost a decade ago.

Months before the pandemic tapered off, we optimistically asked Urantia Foundation for additional copies of *The Urantia Book*. Whereas book shipping used to take two to three months to reach the Philippines, it took almost a year for the last shipment to reach its destination. But the

books did finally arrive, and so did we.

Since 2014, we had traveled almost the entire country, donating Urantia Books to public libraries of universities, colleges, trade schools, and even one resort. Yet in this archipelago of 7,100 islands. hundreds of libraries still lacked a copy. Having recently felt comfortable traveling again, we resolved to continue our dissemination work to libraries we hadn't visited before. I am pleased to report that in the last three months, more than 100 books were placed on these shelves.

We also received many requests for books during our Jesus' birthday celebration in August, where nearly 50 attendees gathered. These books are going to new readers, who eagerly join local study groups. Zoom is an alternative for those living far apart.

While many of these readers start with Part IV, "The Life and Teachings of Jesus," others read sequentially from Paper 1. What a joy to see kindred souls longing for revealed truth! Worth noting is the interest of the youth, some as young as 14, who attend study groups by their own choosing. To the delight of their parents, children come in to say hello and show off their schoolwork while the adults study.

Since our last visit in 2019, there has also been progress in the work of translating *The Urantia Book* into Filipino. After the national conference in November of that year, the translation team met and reached agreement regarding

the daunting work of bringing the spiritual teachings of the revelation to the Philippines. First, each translator agreed to spend two full years reading the book before embarking on their labor of love. They pledged tolerance for the points of view of every other member of the team, along with the humility to seek advice and counsel on passages that are not well understood.

The team also agreed to set up practical guidelines regarding

the frequency and duration of meetings. For example, the team meets three to four times a week on Zoom, for three to four hours each day. The more often the group meets, the better and faster their progress. When power outages occur, each member adjusts and compensates for the lost hours. Confidentiality is observed among the team members, who refrain from discussing the details with inquirers. And each session begins with prayers for spiritual guidance.

Along with Belen, the Filipino translation team

Most importantly, there is unity in spirit. God gives us each a unique personality, and we are each indwelt with a fragment of the Father. As Jesus said, "When did I teach you that you should all see alike? . . . You do not have to see alike or feel alike or even think alike in order spiritually to be alike." 141:5.1 (1591.6)

Yes, teamwork is what the revelators want from us mortals! While translation software is helpful, the translators impart the soul and depth of meaning to the work of the celestial revelators. Layer by layer, as we pursue the best and highest of each meaning from English into Filipino, we have been

enriched spiritually in body, mind, and spirit.

As of now, Papers 1 through 36 have been translated and submitted to Urantia Foundation. We appreciate all the donors who support the propagation of the fifth epochal revelation in the Philippines: "Life is but a day's

work.... The act is ours; the consequences God's." 48:7.13 (556.13)

We handed out a flyer with an image of the book, a guiding message, and a QR code with email addresses so people can connect with us in the future. In addition, we hosted a workshop event, "From Urantia to Paradise."

Our volunteers demonstrated their great enthusiasm by personally communicating with the visitors to our booth. More than 4,000 people showed interest in knowing more about *El libro de Urantia*. We sold 64 books and are thrilled that the message of the revelation is reaching more people!

THIRD EUROPEAN CONFERENCE OF URANTIA BOOK READERS— OVERCOMING MATERIALISM AND ENLIGHTENING EUROPE

The Third European
Conference of Urantia Book
Readers was held October 20–
23, 2022. Almost 70 readers
gathered from Europe and the
rest of the world. They came
from as far away as Georgia in
eastern Europe to the United
States and Argentina in the
Americas. The conference site
was the Sol Torremolinos—Don
Pablo Hotel in Málaga, Spain.
With almost summerlike

temperatures, we were able to enjoy not only the weather, but also the good company of readers and the activities related to the theme of the conference—self-mastery.

The conference had a practical focus so that attendees would return home with new ideas and tools to improve the art of self-mastery in light of the teachings of The Urantia Book. Two tracks were offered in English and Spanish, with workshops that were separate but always focused on selfmastery. As the tracks developed independently, the approaches were different but equally enriching. There were also joint activities that maintained the cohesion of the group of attendees thanks to the translation services.

Since this was the first international face-to-face conference since the outbreak of the pandemic, everyone was eager to meet face to face again and catch up. For this reason, the organizers (whom I

thank for their hard work) wanted to encourage social interactions by including two excursions in the program.

On Friday morning, we visited the Dolmens of Antequera, a World Heritage site with megalithic monuments older than Stonehenge and the pyramids of Egypt. On Saturday evening, we walked through the city of Málaga accompanied by a guide who reviewed the millenary history of the city, which was founded by the Phoenicians. We heard anecdotes about several sites and the character of the local people. Afterwards we enjoyed dinner at a restaurant located on one of the beaches of Málaga.

This was my first conference as a trustee of Urantia Foundation, and I appreciated meeting new readers and cultivating old friendships. I spent time listening carefully and trying to look beyond the program of activities to gauge the health of the Urantia

community in Europe. I must say that the development of the community of readers on this continent continues apace.

There are capable leaders who are working tirelessly to keep the community cohesive. I also saw that the presentations and workshops have evolved: their format has diversified; the content has deepened; the participation of the readers is more sought after. Above all that, there is more focus on applying the teachings in our daily lives.

For all the above reasons, I am certain that a milestone has been reached in the development of the European reading community. Despite being scattered throughout many countries and speaking different languages, European readers have created a common space from which to build a network of support to overcome materialism and enlighten Europe.









Sharing The Urantia Book

Editor's Note: Over the past year News Online has featured a series of articles by individuals who write about how they share The Urantia Book and its teachings with others. We now shift our focus to outreach groups, who collectively share the book and its teachings. We hope their stories will inspire you!

The Prisoner Inquiry Response Team (PIRT) is the longest running Urantia Book dissemination project in the history of Urantia Association International. Its origin is even older. Before PIRT existed, a notable number of letters from inmates began arriving at Urantia Foundation following the seeding of 300 copies of The Urantia Book into prison libraries by Liz Cratty in 2000. The letters and book requests were handled by the Foundation's Reader Services Department. As the number of letters kept growing, assistance from the Association was requested. A service team devoted to providing Urantia Books to incarcerated readers and seekers developed, and PIRT became an official program of the Association.

PIRT replies to each letter sent by an inmate, and books are sent to all who ask for one. A volunteer manages the shipping of 20 to 40 books every month, including to prison libraries and chaplains who hear about *The Urantia Book* from inmates. We thank Urantia Foundation for providing us with their returned books and for offering a good discount on new books.

Since inmates are not allowed to go online to search and connect with groups, PIRT is their primary contact to support their studies of *The Urantia Book*. We try to answer questions about the teachings,

and we send what materials we can, which they often share with their fellows and family. We also support them in their inmate-led study groups.

All who have participated in and contributed to this service throughout its history feel blessed to have assisted truth seekers in discovering the benefits of revealed religion. Following are a few personal words about our service from an inmate and current volunteers who share *The Urantia Book* with our brethren living in some of the darkest corners of Urantia—prisons.

From an Inmate in the USA

"Thank you for reaching out to me. It's good to know that I am being given answers to my inner plea to know the truth of my existence and what is my destiny. I have received a copy of The Urantia Book and am finding peace of mind knowing how much celestial help is placed before me, especially when it comes to my knowing how I have a God fragment living within my mind. Truly we are all blessed. My life is now seen through spiritual eyes. I see now that I am on the shores of a vast opportunity to

experience myself finding God. I understand my part in this universal play and am willing to do the will of God. It starts with my leading others to the truth by leading by example. I am not only a searcher of truth, but I wish for others to find God within. I want to thank you—and all who are helping in this mission of caring about prisoners—for guiding me and opening the doors to my destiny."

From a PIRT Volunteer: Following Jesus' Teachings

"A friend helped me become more conscious of Jesus' teaching affirming all people are children of God, including incarcerated individuals. Helping prisoners realize they are included, helping them choose spiritual values is a role that I can easily accept. The Urantia Book helps them see they really are known on High and are loved, valued. Helping them choose Urantia Book teachings is part of Jesus' commission to 'go into all the world proclaiming this gospel to all nations, to every man, woman, and child." 165:6.3 (1824.6)

From a PIRT Volunteer: Letters from Spanish Readers

"I answer the prisoner mail that is written in Spanish, requesting El libro de Urantia. Most of the letters I receive are from inmates who have heard about the book by word of mouth from another friend in prison. Sometimes there is a bilingual person who has an English copy of the book and translates it for Spanishspeaking inmates, until someone finally writes asking if we have the book in Spanish. It is truly a pleasure to respond to their letters, and I like to send along a couple of pages printed from El libro whenever I write. Hopefully this primes them with a little excitement for reading the book when it arrives. It also gives them something that they can easily share with friends."

From a PIRT Volunteer: Morontia Mota

"It had not occurred to me, when I joined PIRT at its formation 17 years ago, that our group would be participating in realizing a morontia mota teaching. But here it is:


Knowledge is possessed only by sharing; it is safeguarded by wisdom and socialized by love. 48:7:28 (557.12)

"I will tell you this: inmates can ask difficult questions! This one, for example: 'After reading "Government on a Neighboring Planet" in dealing with crime, sentencing to life in detention colonies those believed to be potential criminals is marked as a positive era of law. What does that mean?'

"Here is where the knowledge 'safeguarded by wisdom' of this mota quote comes into play.

"Wisdom to answer to the complete satisfaction of the student and in a way that will ensure their continued study with the revelation.

"Our work with inmates has become a two-way ministry.

We impart awareness to each other; the teacher becomes the student, and the student becomes the teacher. Every aspect of this morontia mota quote is incorporated in our work with inmates. It is truly a labor of love."

WHAT THE URANTIA BOOK MEANS TO ME

In my quest to learn why Melchizedek was only mentioned thrice in the Bible during my confirmation class, my teacher couldn't give me a logical answer. Rather, I was told I was too young to understand certain elements within the Bible. I was defiant and went straight to the parish pastor for answers. He told me that until one studies theology, it's hard to comprehend some biblical verses.

I felt ridiculed by the suggestion that spiritual knowledge was the domain of those initiated into religious dogmas. I protested by walking out of the confirmation class. (To this day, I do not bow to religious doctrines.) I then sought the opinion of my childhood friend Khatukhira

Bernard. He said he could not answer that question, but he took me to his parents' home, where he handed me *The Urantia Book*.

I remember the date the book first spoke to my conscious mind: October 9, 1998. I'd had the book for seven days when I finally opened it. The first paragraph of the Foreword is itself a revelation that takes the reader to the highest and most abstract level of discussing God, far beyond one's cultural background or worship practices.

Unfortunately, Abrahamic religion has created so much confusion, asserting that God

can be understood only through the Abrahamic faith—otherwise one is seen as a pagan. The result is to divide man from God by requiring a perspective alien to people in so many cultures.

There are no greater or more magical words to be found in those Abrahamic religious books than *The Urantia Book*'s statements about God. Even Part IV regarding Jesus' life and teachings cannot really be understood unless the reader has overcome the "conceptual poverty" that has caused them "great confusion respecting the meaning of such terms as God, divinity, and deity." 0:0.1 (1.1)

The Urantia Book removed the veil that had covered my mind then, allowing me an understanding of God-first the God within, then the God without, and finally the God in diversity beyond religious personification. The Spirit of Truth guided me in seeking truth whose revelations came through the different celestial beings, rather than being passed down through oral tradition where meanings were altered and lost. These new revelations serve the higher purpose of truth in ensuring the realization of the brotherhood of man and the Fatherhood of God among Urantia mortals.

Here's a story that may help explain what the book means to me personally. As a child of about six years, I used to live with my stepmom. It so happened that once when my mum visited, I stole some money of hers, something I had never done before. It happened because I was jealous of the lives of my classmates. I spent some of it and returned home. She checked my pocket and found the change. After she gave me a harsh talking-to, I remained alone and heard a voice speak to me, saying "go apologize to her, and give her back the remaining money." I heeded the voice, and felt a weight lifted off my shoulders, as my mum said, "it's not your fault, son!"

So, what does *The Urantia Book* mean to me? The key is the Thought Adjuster, whose leading I believe I experienced as a young child, showing me

how freewill choice comes in handy once one has tuned oneself to the voice of the Adjuster, who is the bridge between the Universal Father and the imperfect mortal mind.

In Paper 2, a Divine Counselor tells us that "divine mercy represents a fairness technique of adjustment between the universe levels of perfection and imperfection." 2:4.5 (38.5) And we also read in that same section that "mercy is simply justice tempered by that wisdom which grows out of perfection of knowledge and the full recognition of the natural weaknesses and environmental handicaps of finite creatures." 2:4:1 (38.1) This mercy ministry does not directly convey the realization of the perfection of divine love, but that was revealed to me later as I grew to appreciate the intervention of divine mercy.

What prospects do I see for sharing this revelation with others? In the end, the ambiguity of the God concept can only be appreciated when local cultural deity meanings are embraced in harnessing humanity diversity. To address this need, I can envision a future in which Uganda. already in the heart of Africa, may become a hub for the revelation of The Urantia Book in Africa, a place to anchor the global Urantia Book movement for the realization of the brotherhood of man and the Fatherhood of God.


